2012 President's Report

The Frivolous Ultimate Inc was formally constituted and incorporated on 12 November 2011. The club began with ten members at the IGM followed by an influx of players over the year to a total of 19 new members by the end of September - our financial year. We are excited by the quick growth of the club in our first year and look forward to continuing this growth over the coming years.

Frivolous ran two new events in the Hobart ultimate calendar - the Kingston Beach League and Frivolous 7s. The Kingston Beach League was run over 6 weeks in February and March. We had 28 players, including 11 women and 17 men, play in the league. *Weeds* finished at the top of the ladder and *Truckers* narrowly won spirit. By all accounts everyone enjoyed the opportunity to play in a beach league for the first time. Thanks to Matt Petrie, Dave Cooke, Stew Wilde, Andy Cole, John Kristensen and Charlie Prevost for helping to run this event.

In May Frivolous ran its first tournament - Frivolous 7s. The Savage 7 style tournament had four teams of five men and two women that fought through the wet and wild weather, with *Vintage* winning the final and *Snow Seven* and *the White Dwarves* winning spirit. Thanks to the four captains - Ange Charles, Matt Petrie, Matt Lyons and Charlie Prevost for organising their teams and to John Kristensen for organising this event with assistance from Stew Wilde and Charlie Prevost.

Frivolous also entered a team into the TUA Winter Advanced League. Despite several injuries and absences *Handle with Care* played well throughout the league finishing 4th on the ladder.

On the administration side of things, we have established a working relationship with the Kingborough Council. This has resulted in support from the Council in the promotion of the beach league on their community calendar and by providing us with quality fields and facilities for our events. We would also like to thank the TUA for providing score boards and other equipment for both of our events.

Financially Frivolous is in a sound position, thanks to our membership and two successful events.

A special mention should go to Stew Wilde, Alysha Prevost, Charlie Prevost, Andy Cole, Nick Moles and John Kristensen for providing the inspiration and putting in the time and energy in order for us to form the first incorporated ultimate club in Hobart.
